

POSTOPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS

Call our office if

- 1) Fever is greater than 102.
- 2) Bleeding occurs.
- 3) Surgical area becomes red, swollen, warm to touch, or drains pus.
- 4) Patient vomits more than twice in a 24-hour period.
- 5) Patient becomes listless, hard to arouse.
- 6) Urine changes color, especially if it becomes cola-colored.

Follow your surgeon's instructions regarding

- 1) Diet as tolerated, unless instructed otherwise.
- 2) Drink plenty of fluids.
- 3) Wound Care:
 - Keep incision clean and dry.
 - Avoid tension or pulling at stitches.
 - Coat suture line gently with Neosporin, Bactroban, or other antibiotic ointment using a Q-tip as instructed by physician.
 - Change dressing as ordered by physician.
 - If steri-strips have been applied to the operative site, they will fall off by themselves.
- 4) Avoid blood thinners such as Aspirin, Ibuprofen, Coumadin, Heparin, or any NSAID for 14 days following surgery.
- 5) Avoid strenuous activities or becoming overheated for 14 days following surgery.
