

# Postoperative Care Instructions Following Zenker's Diverticulectomy

## Medications

- Alternate Tylenol (acetaminophen) 500mg with Motrin 600mg every 3 hours as needed for pain.
- Take antibiotics as prescribed.
- Resume all other medications unless otherwise noted.

#### Activity

- For 24 hours: Limit your activity for the next 24 hours and get plenty of rest.
- For 1 week: No heavy lifting or pushing, active sports, strenuous exercise, or heavy household work. Objects more than ten pounds are considered too heavy.
- Some blood-tinged mucus is normal right after surgery.

### Diet

- Maintain a soft diet for one week following surgery.
- Advance diet as tolerated after one week or when cleared by your doctor.

# Call your doctor (or go to the emergency room) if you have.

- Fever over 101.5 F
- Any active bleeding
- Any trouble breathing.
- Neck becomes red, swollen, or warm to touch.
- Patient becomes listless, hard to arouse.
- Urine changes color, especially if it becomes cola colored.
